





Total Change in U.S. Employment, Monthly Jan 1990 – Dec 2019




Shaded areas are recessions

Total Change in U.S. Employment, Monthly Jan 1990 – Dec 2019




Total Change in U.S. Employment, Monthly Jan 1990 – Nov 2020




Shaded areas are recessions




U3, U.S., Atlanta and Georgia over the last year
